1. Stinson Beach parking and services reopen 6/5/2020 with a good assist from County of Marin, thanks to the good communication and problem solving built through OneTam collaboration. Please follow safe distancing and protective measures, plus LNT (leave no trace: pack it in, pack it out).
2. Another good OneTam product: this interactive map on what's open/closed in our Marin parklands:

3. Siren Canteen exploring options to reopen very soon, too!
4. NPS will be rehabilitating the lifeguard tower over next couple of years. Also working closely with Siren Canteen to continue service during construction.
5. FHWA has had several good discussions with Zone 5 Flood Board and County to brief on north parking lot project scope, other possible improvements that can be accomplished during this work. We hope to receive 30% design drawings later this summer. And, the engagement process has included developing awareness of other contributing studies and work for a healthier, better functioning system that will also minimize impacts to neighboring communities.
6. Work orders have gone in to replace planks on bridge at western end of Matt Davis Trail, safety alert signage at western connection with PanHwy and Dipsea, hazard trees at Easkoot Crossing and failed culvert at beach entrance gate impacting library. Approvals rec'd to update NPS park signage on Highway 1.
