RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION

Recruitment and Retention continues to be the organization's biggest challenge. A Physician's Assistant who appeared to be the perfect hire, resigned after 9 months due to a long commute. CHA has engaged two different recruiters to help find the perfect W. Marin candidate. As a result of the staffing shortage, Bolinas will again close on Fridays, but SB will switch from Thursday to Friday to ensure the southern patients have access on Fridays. There is also hope that a Friday schedule may attract weekenders, improving low productivity.

POLICY
