SB Fire Protection District/SB Volunteer Fire Dept./SB Disaster Council -

Fire Chief Kenny Stevens and the volunteers of the SB Disaster Council invite everyone in Stinson Beach to attend a free **Hands On CPR training session** to be held on **Tuesday, April 18, 2017**, from **7:00-9:00 PM** at the **SB Community Center**. A demonstration on how to use the Automated External Defibrillator will be given as well. The training will be given by Chief Stevens along with Wills Kelly, a professional paramedic, and Jesse Peri, a paramedic in training. The CPR Training session is co-sponsored by the Stinson Beach Community Center.

All community members also are encouraged to take Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training. The training takes 18 hours. The next two-day training is scheduled for **Sat., May 13th**, and **Sat., May 20th**, from **8:30 AM - 5:30 PM** at the Marin County Corporation Yard, 5600 Nicasio Valley Road in Nicasio.

Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) is a national program that is part of Citizens Corps under the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). CERTs are volunteers who have gone through a training process that enables them to participate in the public safety response in a community following a large scale emergency or disaster.

A fee of \$45.00 per trainee is charged to defray the costs of the training. Full scholarships are available.
