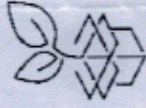
It's free and only takes a few minutes. Just answer some basic questions about your home. You'll learn what changes can help you save energy and lower your bills.

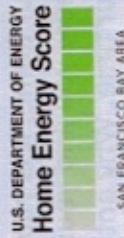

Home+ provides rebates of up to \$5,000 for energy efficiency projects including insulation upgrades, air sealing, furnace replacements, hot water heater replacements, and more.
