The first contract is basically complete and all comfort stations are operating and complete.

Later this month the contractor will complete final communications panel enabling facilities division to remotely monitor the systems operations.

A new contract for the addition of new picnic area benches, bbq's, water fountains, waste and recycling containers as well as a wooden compliant walkway to the beach should be awarded in August. We are expecting about three months of construction to see that project completed.
