

Sbfd Ambulance Director January 2019 Report

For this last period we had a total of **13 medical calls**:

Non-Transports 3 (*Release at Scene, Against Medical Advice, or No patient found*)

Ground Ambulance Transports 9

Air Ambulance Transports 1

Of those we responded to: MVA/Hyperglycemic episode, Motorcycle Accident / Forearm Fracture, Hip Dislocation/Femur Fracture, Flu-like Symptoms (A91 Transport), syncopal episodes/hematemesis, breathing problem, Fall, dislocated shoulder on the Matt Davis trail, traumatic head injury, MVA / Head Injury, bicycle accident, possible stroke/TIA, ETOH,

-EMT Class had their first lecture on Wednesday and is in their second as we speak tonight. First skills class starts Feb 3rd. We have 6 Sbfd volunteers, two members of the Tam Fire Crew, One NPS park ranger, and one town resident. Many agencies are benefiting from this class.
