Report to the SBVA - September 2, 2017

The National Weather Service has issued a Red Flag Warning for Marin County which currently is expected to be in place through 9:00 PM tonight.

A Red Flag Warning means critical fire weather conditions are either occurring now or will shortly. A combination of strong winds, low relative humidity and warm temperatures can contribute to extreme fire behavior.

Fire Chief Kenny Stevens asks everyone to be extra alert for signs of fire. Mt. Tam is especially vulnerable as it is overdue for a potentially devastating 100-year fire.

As smoke from wildfires in Northern California currently is drifting into Marin, dial 911 ONLY if you actually see signs of fire.

To Protect Your Home & Family During Red Flag Warnings:

- 1.) Do not use charcoal BBQ's
- 2.) Do not use power tools outdoors
- 3.) Clean ALL leaves & needles from your roof, rain gutters and around your house
- 4.) Do not drive or park on dry grass
